The Clintonville-Beechwold Community Resources Center was founded in 1971 by a group of North Broadway United Methodist Church (NBUMC) members who lived in Clintonville. They assessed the needs of the Clintonville-Beechwold area and discovered social problems as well as resources. From there, they wanted to create something separate from NBUMC where neighbors could help neighbors.

As part of the century-old Settlement House Movement, CRC is a community-based social services agency that brings people together to help individuals and families build upon their strengths. We promote self-sufficiency while respecting individual worth, rights, and dignity; Thus, creating a greater quality of life for everyone throughout the community. When needs arise, CRC responds.

CRC is part of the Columbus Federation of Settlements and member of the Human Service Chamber of Franklin County.

CRC Senior Supportive Services


We value all that older adults offer as members of our community. Through a myriad of services, we help older adults remain independent and safe in their homes.

CRC Personal Finance Management



CRC Kinship Care






